New Service Provider Training

Is the premier training for staff new to working with survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault, and is essential for creating an informed and skilled workforce.

Developed in 1996 by the Michigan Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence (MCADSV) and the Michigan Domestic Violence Prevention and Treatment Board (MDVPTB), the training fulfills a critical need for high quality, standardized training for service providers. New Service Provider Training has received national acclaim as being one of the first standardized curriculum for domestic violence and sexual assault service providers.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND? Paid employees of MDVPTB-funded agencies and direct recipients of federal STOP funding, with a year or less of experience.
